



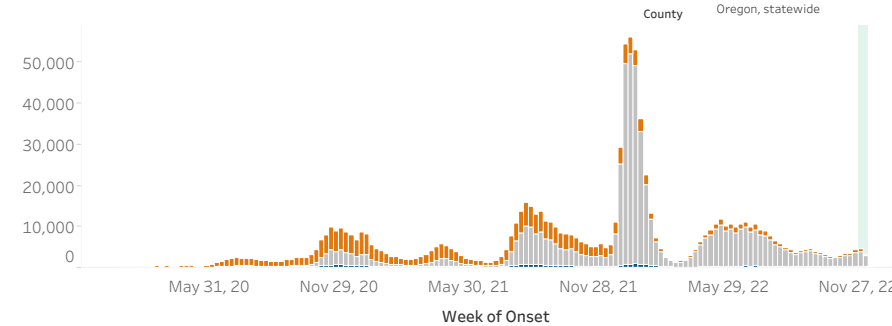

### Oregon's Epidemiologic Curve

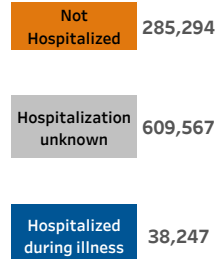
When people say we want to "flatten the curve," this is the curve they are talking about. An epidemiologic curve, or epi curve, shows the number of COVID-19 cases by date of illness onset. Sudden surges of COVID-19 infections can lead to more people needing medical care than our hospital systems can treat at one time. By "flatten the curve" we mean we want to slow the number of new cases of COVID-19 so our healthcare system is not overwhelmed and can provide care to everyone who needs it. Vaccination is the safest and most effective way to stop the spread of COVID-19.

This chart shows the number of Oregonians who have been identified as COVID-19 cases and whether they were ever hospitalized for their illness.

### Oregon's COVID-19 cases have come in waves

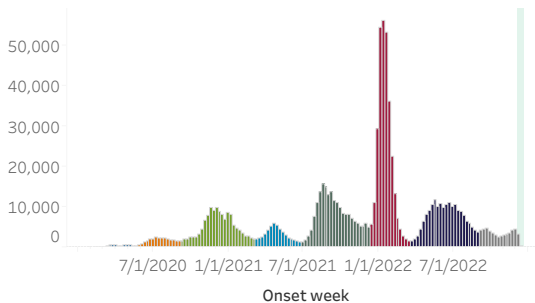
As is common for infectious diseases, COVID-19 has been marked by rises and falls of varying sizes in new case counts as factors like new variants, vaccinations, and people gathering affect its spread. The charts below estimate statewide waves by assigning the lowest weekly (Sunday to Saturday) case count between peaks as the end of the previous wave. The third statewide wave (which peaked in winter 2020), fifth statewide wave (which peaked in summer 2021), and seventh statewide wave (which peaked in spring 2022) were the longest in duration. The sixth statewide wave has the highest number of weekly cases. To allow for some variation in the data, a new statewide wave will not be assigned until three consecutive weeks of increased case counts are reported.

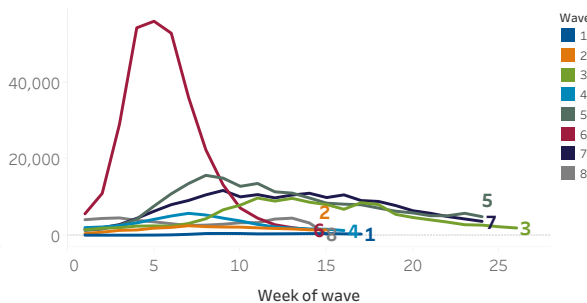
