  - (3) En un área no autorizada.
- E. Aditamentos o aparatos para escape
- F. Dinero, incluyéndose cualquier documento negociable y estampillas (timbres, sellos) de correo sin cancelar o sellar.
- G. Embriagantes; y/o Producto o rédito procedente de apuestas ni objetos ni aparatos para hacer apuestas.

### RULE OF PROHIBITED CONDUCT:

Rule #7 Possession, Manufacture, or Use of Dangerous Contraband: Except as may be authorized by other rules, no inmate shall knowingly possess, manufacture or use:

- (a) Weapons;
- (b) Explosives;
- (c) Narcotics or narcotics paraphernalia;
- (d) Controlled medication of another, in excess of authorization, and/or in an unauthorized area;
- (e) Escape devices;
- (f) Money, including negotiable instruments and uncanceled stamps;
- (g) Intoxicants; and/or
- (h) Gambling proceeds, or paraphernalia.
