



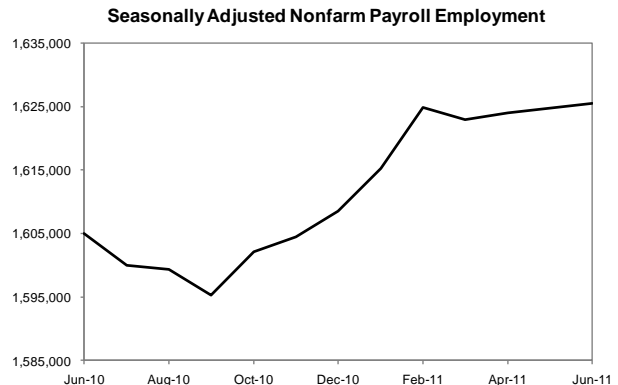

Workforce & Economic Research Fast Facts – July 2011

- Oregon had an unemployment rate of 9.4 percent in June, which ranked 15th highest nationwide.
- In June, the number of unemployed Oregonians dropped by 16,629 (-7.8%) from the previous year.
- From June 2010 to June 2011, total nonfarm employment growth in Oregon (1.4%) ranked 13th fastest among all states.
- Oregon's government employment dropped 2.7 percent over the year, ranking 31st among the states
