

**PNEUMONIA (Including Pneumococcal, Bacterial other than Pneumococcal, and Primary Atypical [Virus] Pneumonia)**

1. **REPORTING:** Required
2. **PLACARDING:** None
3. **ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE:** Limited to concurrent and terminal disinfection.
4. **SPECIAL MEASURES:** Pneumonia patients should not be allowed to occupy the same room with other persons whose resistance has been lowered by age, exposure or illness.

**LABORATORY AIDS:** Sputum for culture may be submitted in the standard sputum specimen outfits for etiologic diagnosis of the bacterial pneumonias (if indicated); two or more 5 cc samples of whole blood, best collected near the onset and after 14-21 days, may be submitted in the standard widal outfits for diagnosis of virus pneumonia. Be sure to request examination for bacterial pneumonia on the sputum specimens and for cold agglutinins on the blood specimens. This service is seldom of value except in epidemiologic investigations since the report cannot usually be rendered in time to benefit the individual patient.

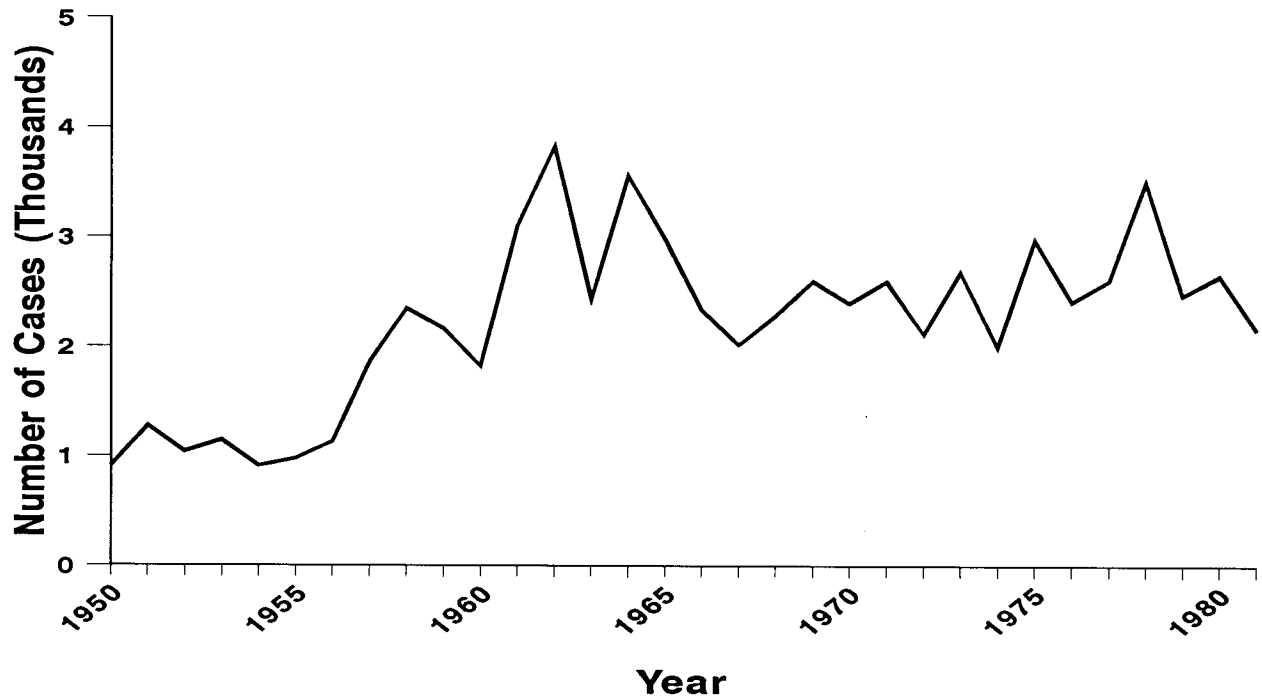
