

HEPATITIS, INFECTIOUS (EPIDEMIC JAUNDICE, ACUTE CATARRHAL JAUNDICE)

1. REPORTING: Required

2. PLACARDING: None.

3. ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE: Isolation procedures listed below should be followed for the first week of illness and sanitary disposal of excreta should be enforced until clinical recovery.

The case shall have a separate room screened against flies and other insects.

Only persons essential to the care of the patient may be admitted to the patient's room.

Persons entering the patient's room shall wear a washable gown or coverall apron while attending the patient and remove it immediately upon leaving the patient's room.

Persons leaving the patient's room shall wash their hands with soap and water and/or suitable disinfectant before handling any objects outside the room.

All eating utensils used in the patient's room shall be boiled for 15 minutes or otherwise disinfected as directed by the health officer immediately after removal from the room. Food scraps should be burned at once or carefully wrapped prior to ultimate disposal.

All linens used by the patient shall be boiled for fifteen minutes or otherwise disinfected as directed by the health officer immediately after removal from the room.

Discharges from the patient's nose, mouth or skin lesions shall be collected in paper or cloth, deposited in clean paper bags and burned immediately upon removal from the room.

In the case of enteric diseases, discharges from the patient's bladder and bowels shall be treated with a suitable chemical disinfectant such as bichloride of lime or saponated cresol as directed by the health officer prior to ultimate disposal.

4. SPECIAL MEASURES: Food handling restrictions according to Regulation X apply.

REGULATION X. FOOD HANDLING

- A. When a case of cholera, diphtheria, epidemic diarrhea, amebic dysentery, bacillary dysentery, infectious hepatitis, meningococcus meningitis, paratyphoid fever, poliomyelitis, salmonellosis, septic sore throat, scarlet fever, smallpox, tuberculosis,

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or typhoid fever exists on any farm or dairy producing milk, cream, butter, cheese, or other products likely to be consumed raw, no such food shall be sold or delivered from such farm or dairy except under the following provisions:

1. That such foods for sale are not brought into the house where such case exists.
 - B. That all persons coming in contact with such foods, eat, sleep and work wholly outside of such house and not come in contact in any way with such house or its inmates or contents.
 - C. That all inmates are properly isolated and separated from all parts of said farm or dairy.
 - D. That a permit be issued by the health officer, and such premises be open to his inspection at all times.
- B. No person affected with any communicable disease shall handle food or food products intended for sale. All persons handling or preparing food stuffs or beverages for sale shall have a physical examination by a doctor of medicine whenever desired and requested by the state or local health officers, for the purpose of determining the presence of a communicable disease, particularly, for tuberculosis and the typhoid-paratyphoid-dysentery diseases.
