2013-2014

The **2013-2014 Oregon Vehicle Code Book** is now available for purchase. The cost of the book is \$7 per copy, which covers the cost of publishing and distribution.

*Format* – The books are approximately 5½ by 8½ inches in size and are available in both a paperback and loose-leaf version. There is a limited number of loose-leaf (notebook style) books available. The loose-leaf format requires a three-ring binder, which is **not** provided by DMV. Requests for loose-leaf books will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis until the supply has been exhausted. If there are no loose-leaf books available, requests will be filled with the paperback version of the book.

Please be sure to include the complete name and address where you want the books shipped. If the books need to come to a particular person's attention, please include that information in your request. Please state the number of books you are requesting, as well as the format (see above). It is also a good idea to include a phone number and the name of the person to be contacted in case there are any questions about your request. **You must send payment (by check or money order only) with your request, as DMV is unable to process requests without proper payment.**

DUII Diversion for CDL Holders

For some time, Oregon courts and DMV have been working together toward compliance with the prohibition against persons who hold commercial driver licenses (CDLs) being granted DUII diversion. This is found both in federal regulation [49 CFR 384.226](#) and in Oregon statute [ORS 153.090\(7\)](#).

Each year, we have seen improvement in the numbers of CDL holders who were granted DUII diversion:



2008:	72
2009:	42
2010:	29
2011:	26
2013:	22

As of June 30, only two DUII diversions have been granted to CDL holders in 2014, and none have been granted in the last four months. This is excellent progress toward bringing Oregon into compliance with this important element of the federal CDL program.
