Cape Blanco State Airport

Cape Blanco (5S6)

Constructed in 1944-45 by the Civil Aeronautics Authority as the Curry County Airport and was then leased to the U.S. Navy, Curry County owned part of the property and part of it was leased from the Oregon State Highway Department. The county portion of the airport was acquired by Aeronautics in 1966 and Aeronautics took possession of the airport at that time. The portion owned by the Oregon Highway Department was transferred to Aeronautics in 1971. No facilities are located at the airport.

Cape Blanco State Airport was constructed by the U.S. Bureau of Public Roads and was used by the U.S. Navy. In 1966, the Board of

Aeronautics acquired the airport from Curry County and the State Highway Department. Located approximately three miles southwest of the community of Denmark, west of U.S. Route 101, Cape Blanco State Airport is situated one mile from the Pacific Ocean.

The airport plays a supportive role in the current system, providing access to the surrounding recreational areas, including several State parks, the Oregon Islands National Wildlife Refuge, and the Orford and Blanco reefs. There are several large turboprop business aircraft currently operating at the airport. The location of the airport also allows for continuation of the Oregon coastal airport system.
