## Duck License Plates – New Plate

Effective April 1, 2019

**DUCK LICENSE PLATES** • The University of Oregon Alumni Association (UOAA) Duck license plate will be available to the public beginning April 1, 2019.

Duck plates will be available only for passenger vehicles, and have their own unique background. The plate configuration will be consistent with Salmon, Crater Lake, Cultural, Wine Country, Trail Blazers and Gray Whale plates and has two alpha characters on the left of the plate, one above the other, followed by five numeric characters. The Duck plate configuration will start with **UO 00001** making it unique because DMV does not typically use the letter O on a standard configuration plate.



Duck license plates will also be available as Custom (Personalized) and Amateur Radio Operator (Ham) plates.

The previous UO group plate on the tree background with the UO decal will no longer be issued, but can still be renewed and transferred to other eligible passenger vehicles.
