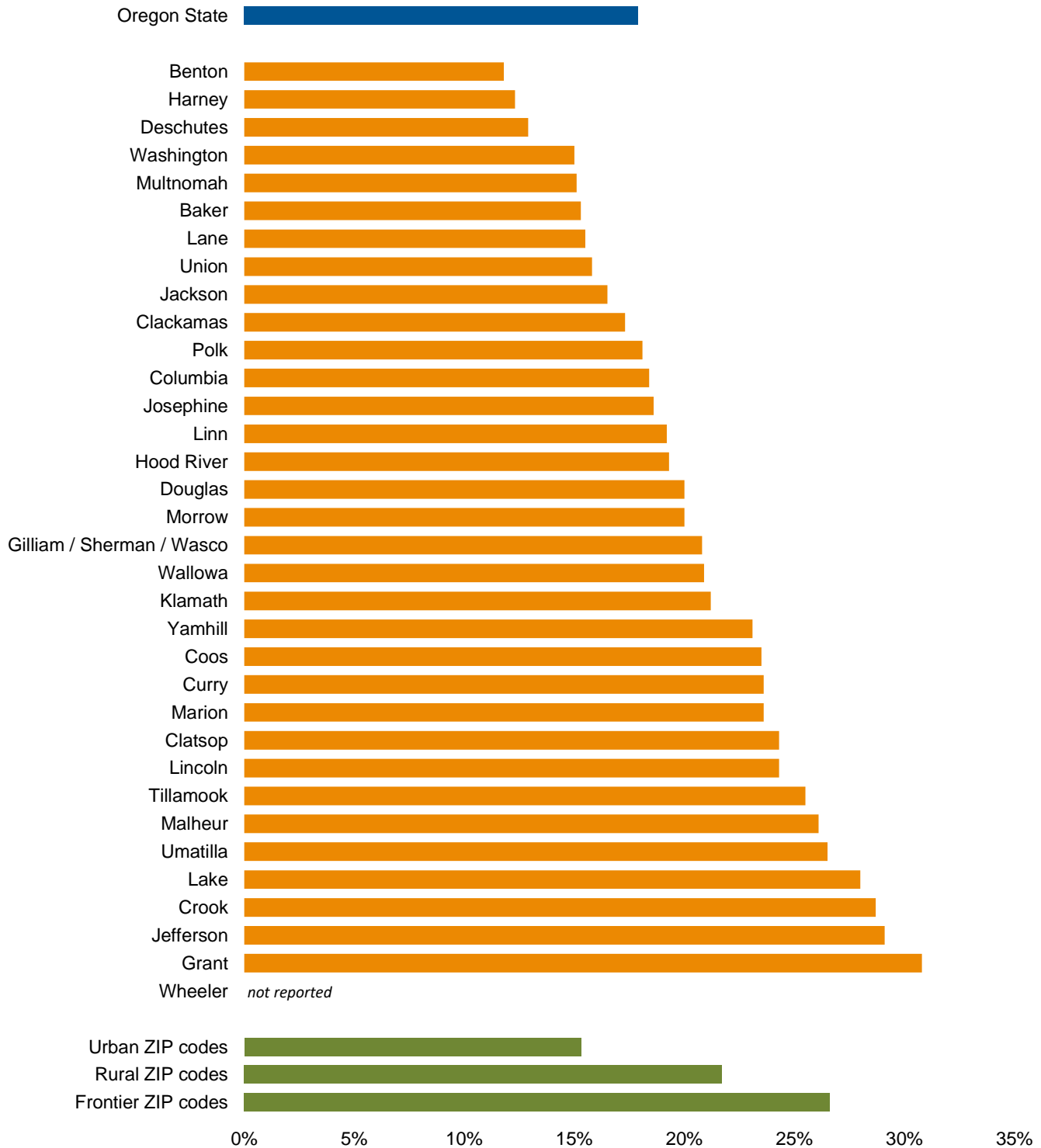


Physical inactivity among adults by county, Oregon, 2014–2017
