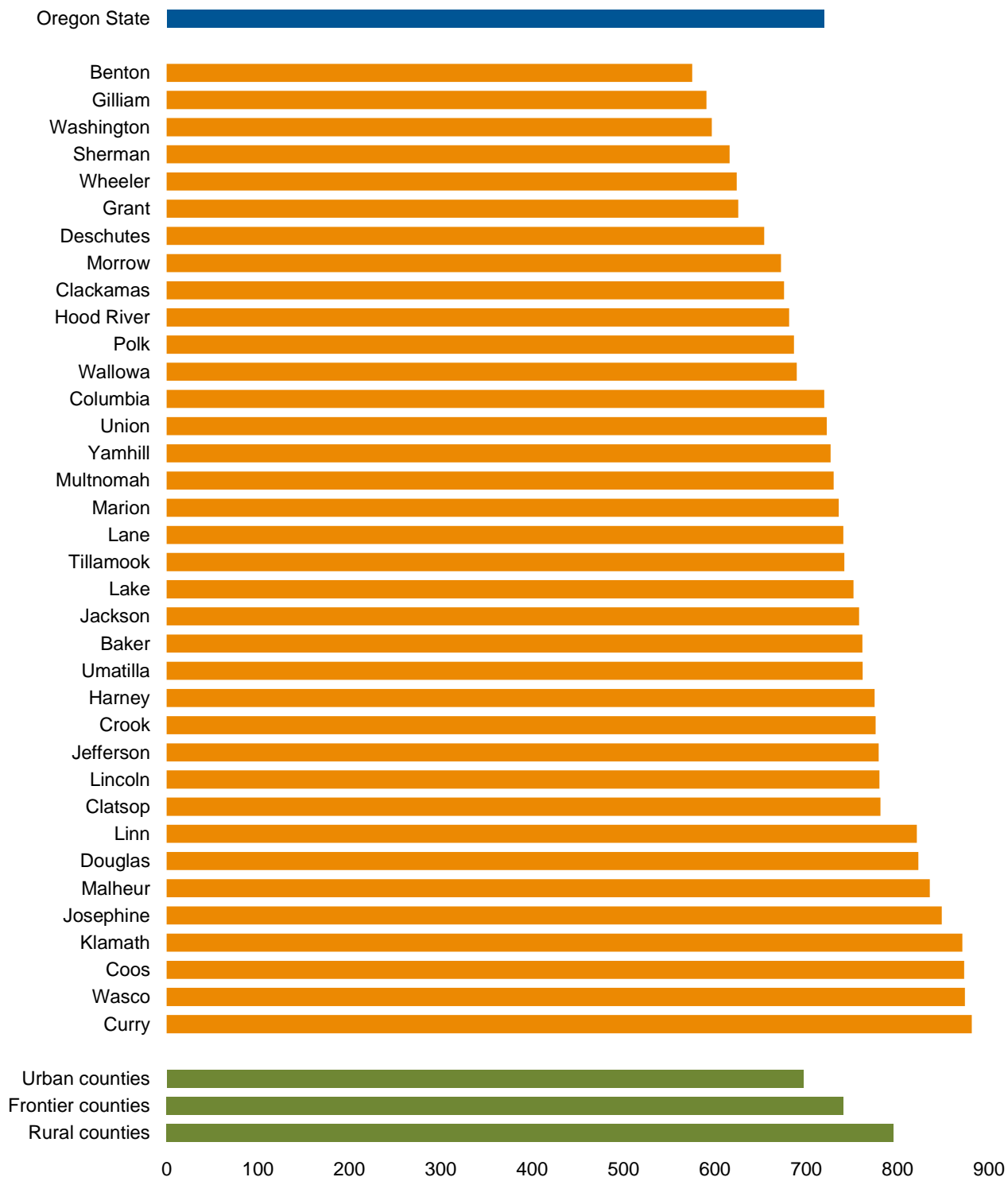


Leading causes of death by county, Oregon, 2013–2017

Rate per 100,000 population (age-adjusted)



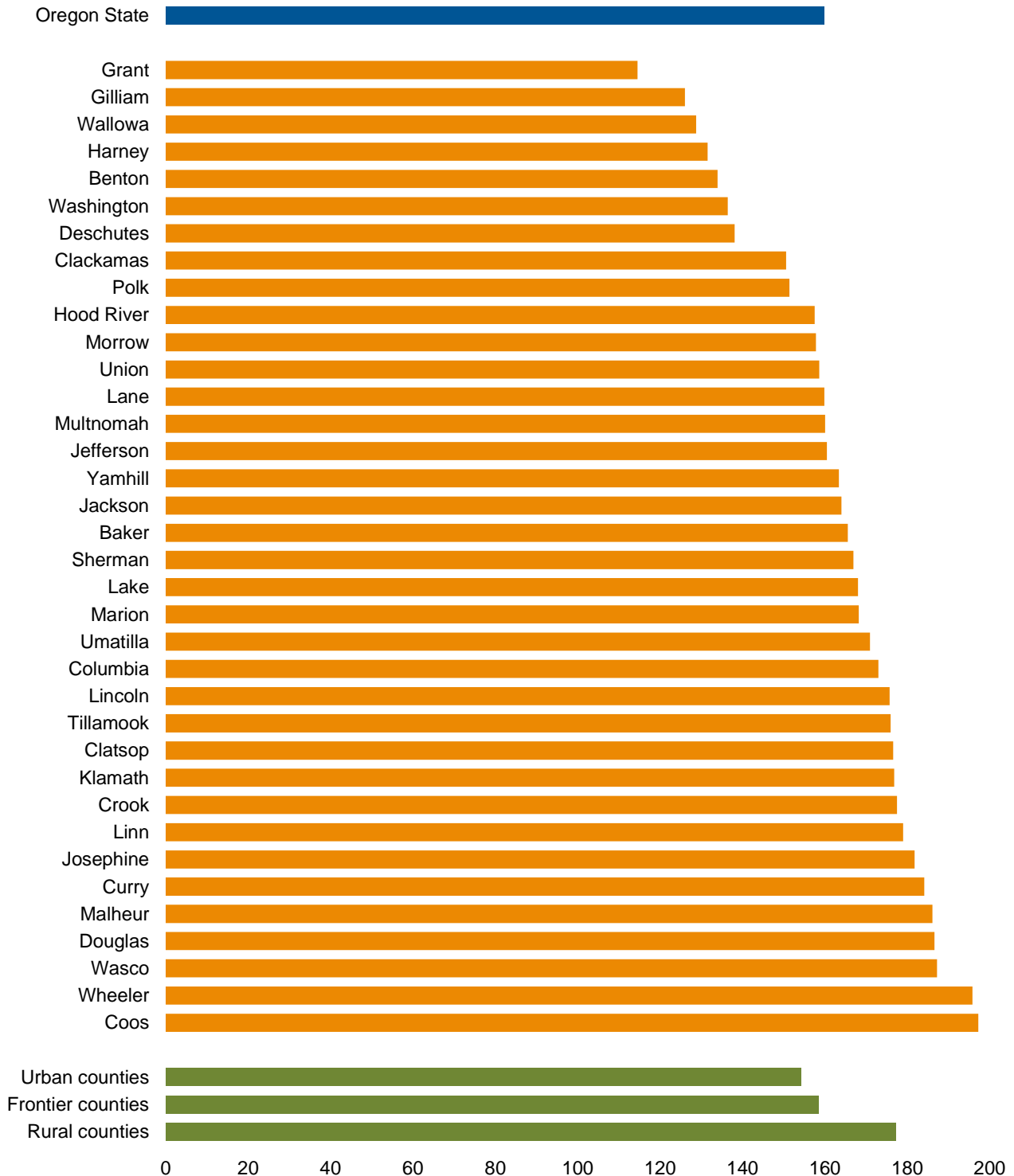

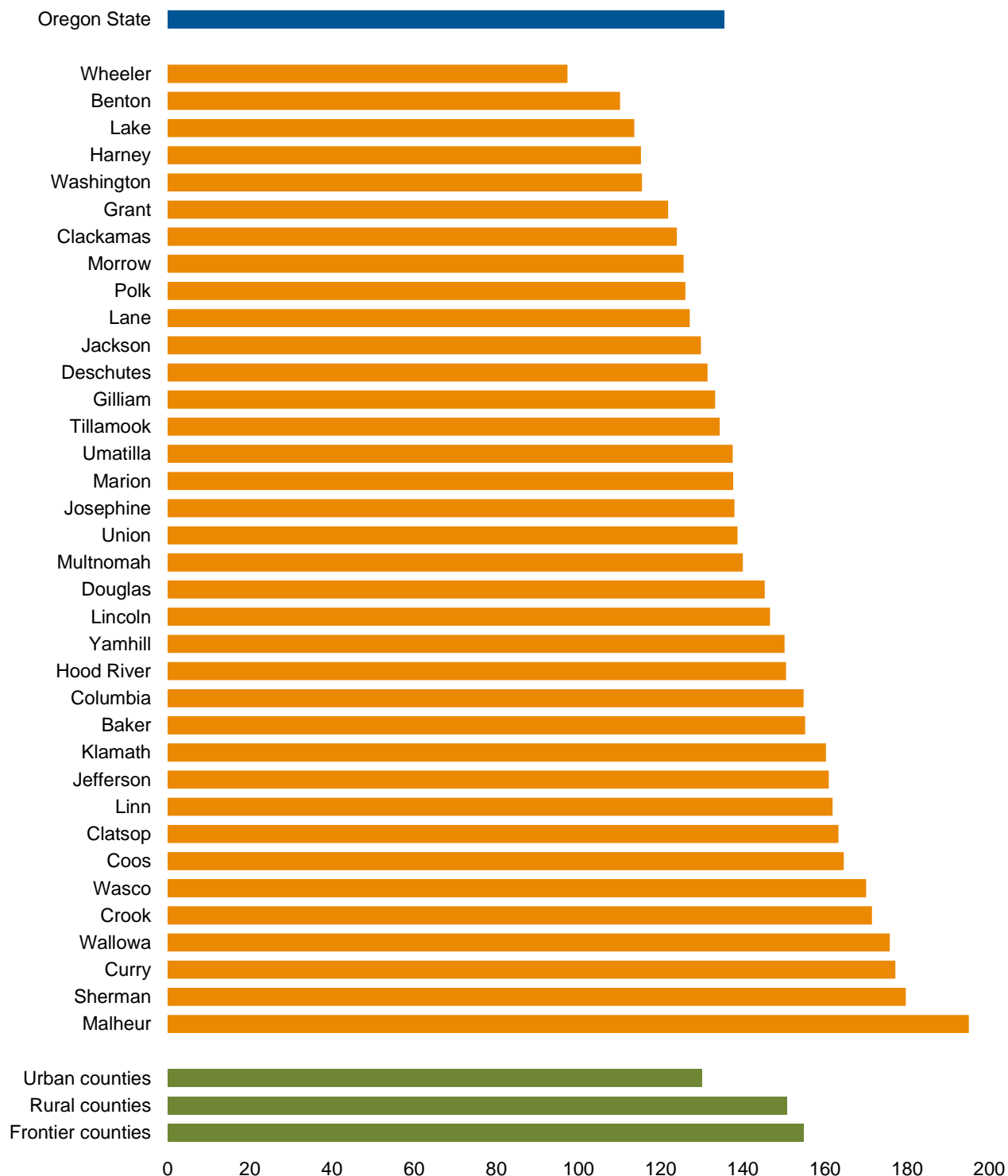

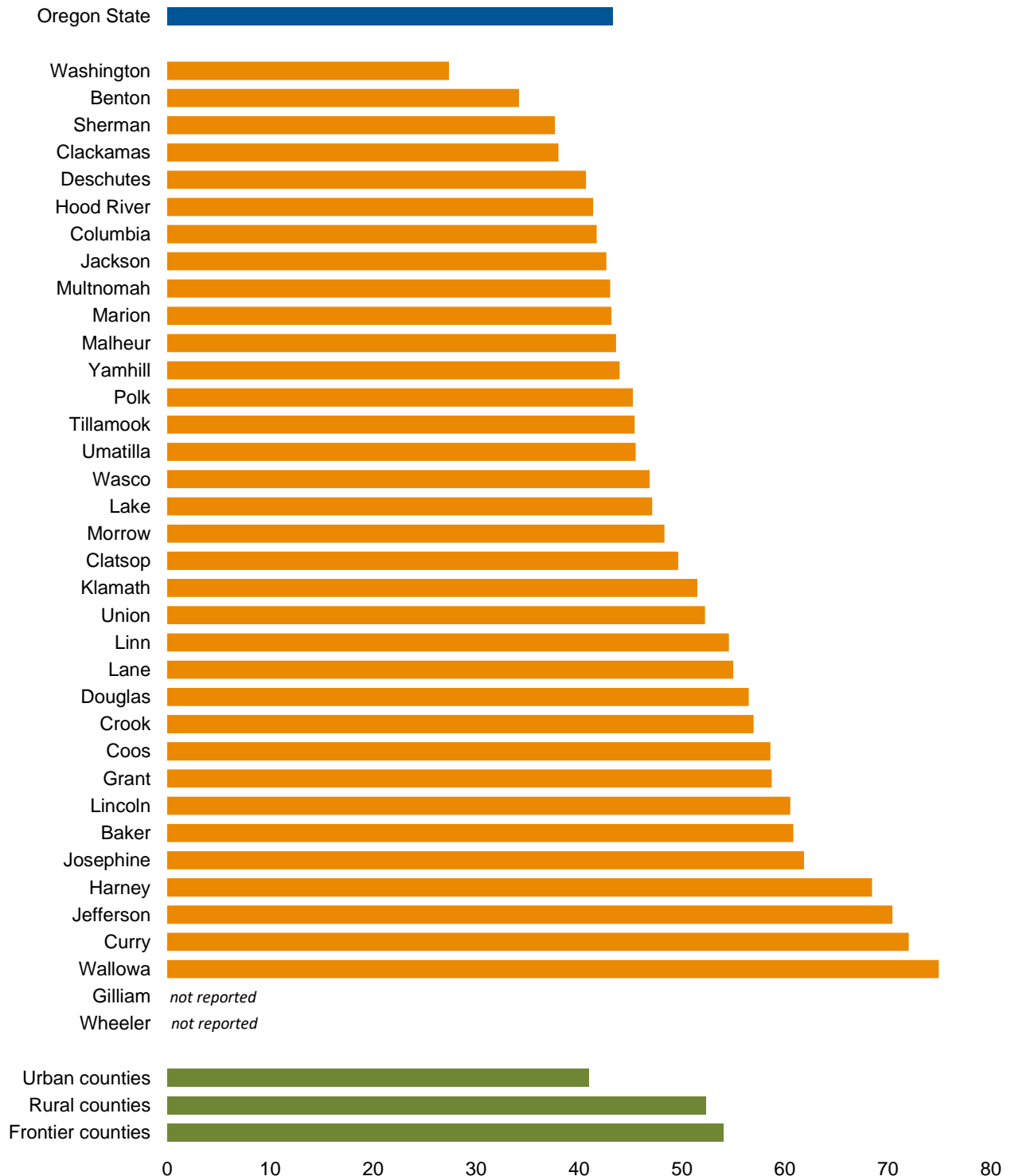

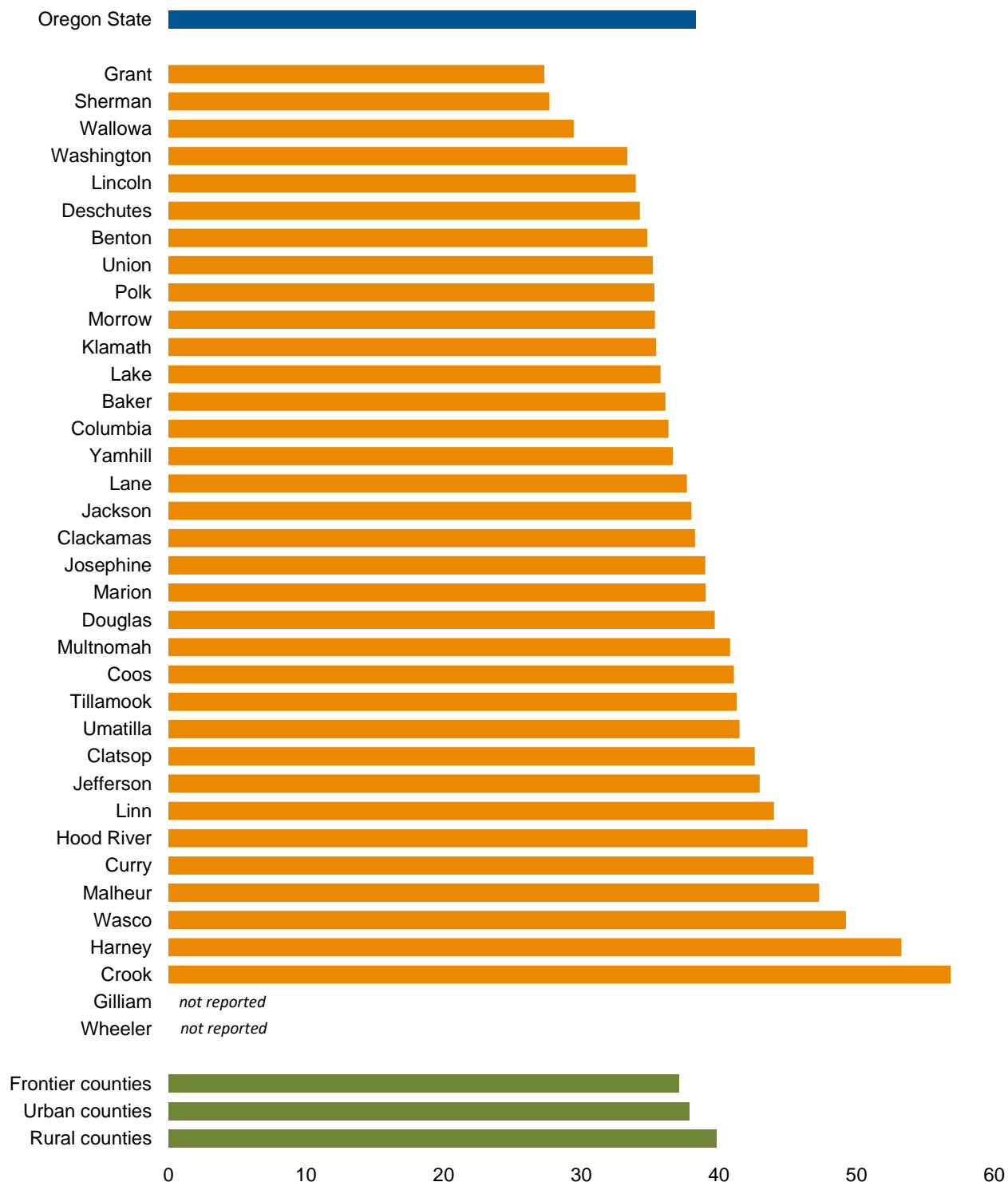

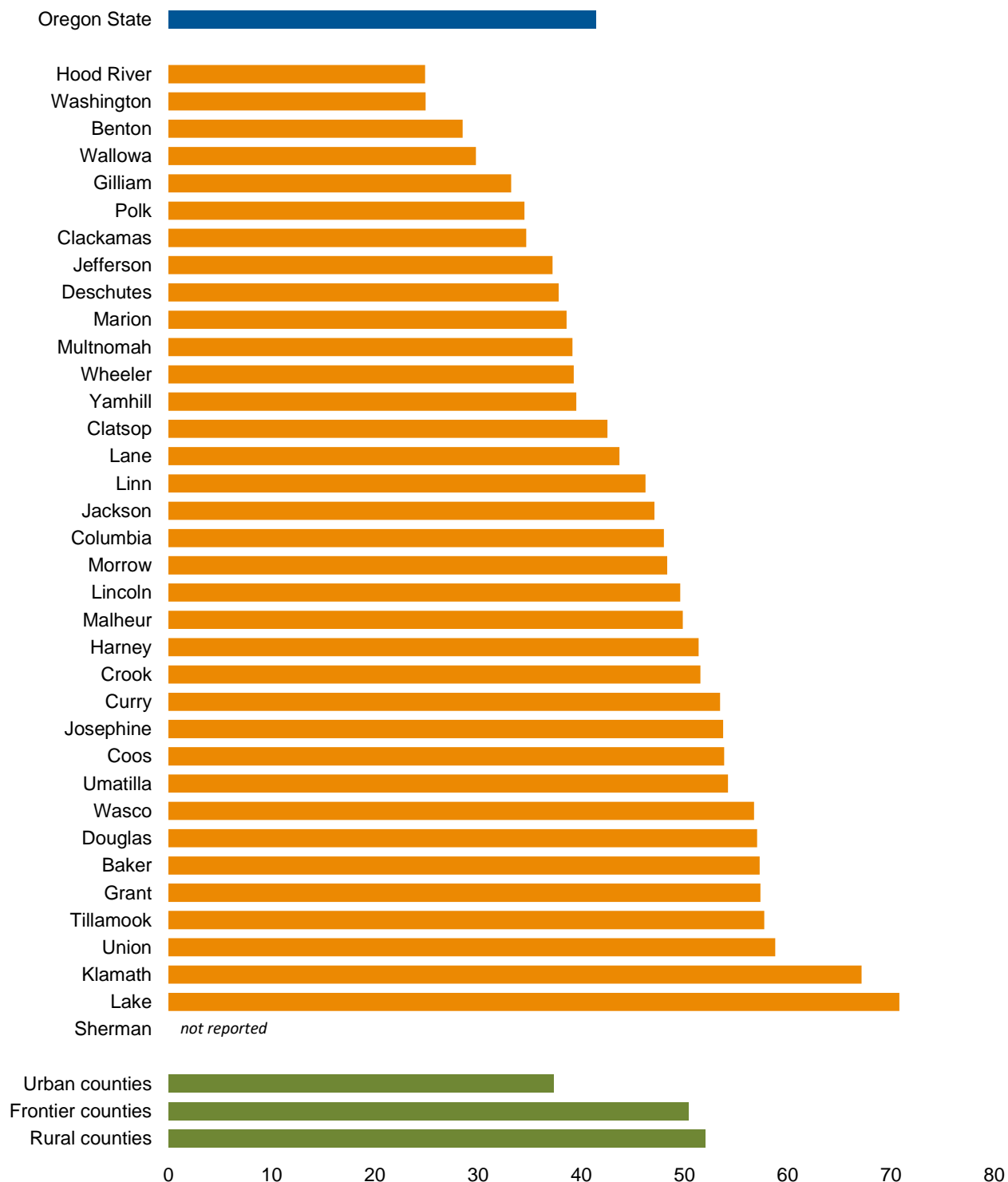
