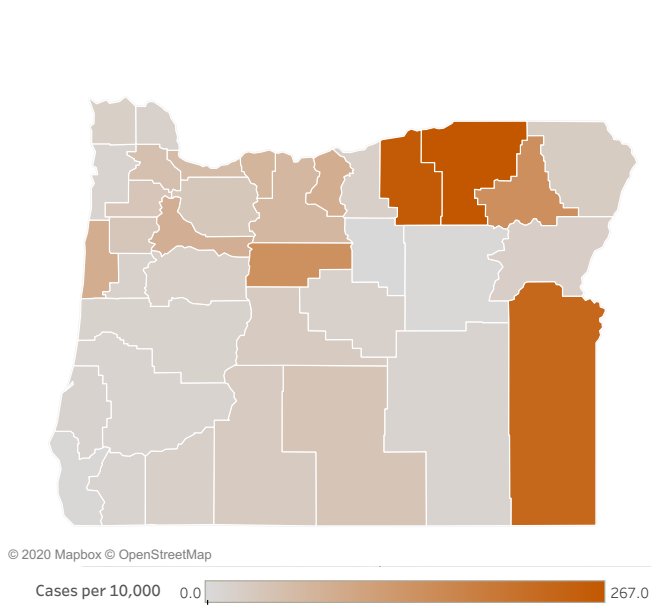

Trends in Test Positivity

Oregon's COVID-19 Testing and Outcomes by County

This map shows the number of COVID-19 cases per 10,000 people by county in Oregon.* The number of cases in a community depends, in part, on the number of people who live there. Looking at the numbers this way helps us compare counties of different sizes more evenly than total case counts alone.

Hover over a county in the map below to see the total number of cases, recovered cases, deaths, and positive and negative tests in that county. The table s..

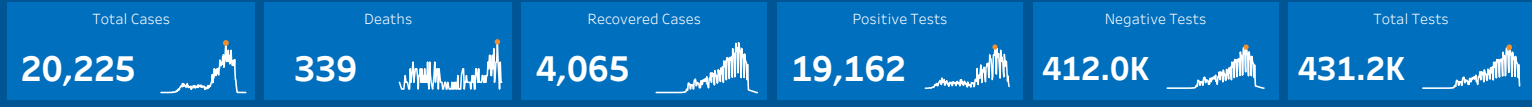

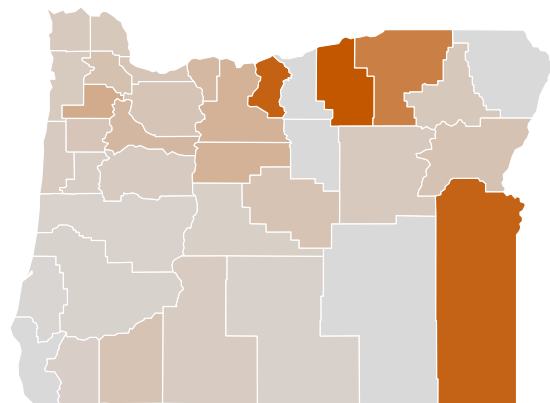

Percent Positivity Total Persons Tested



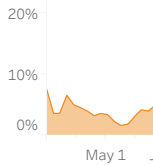

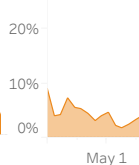

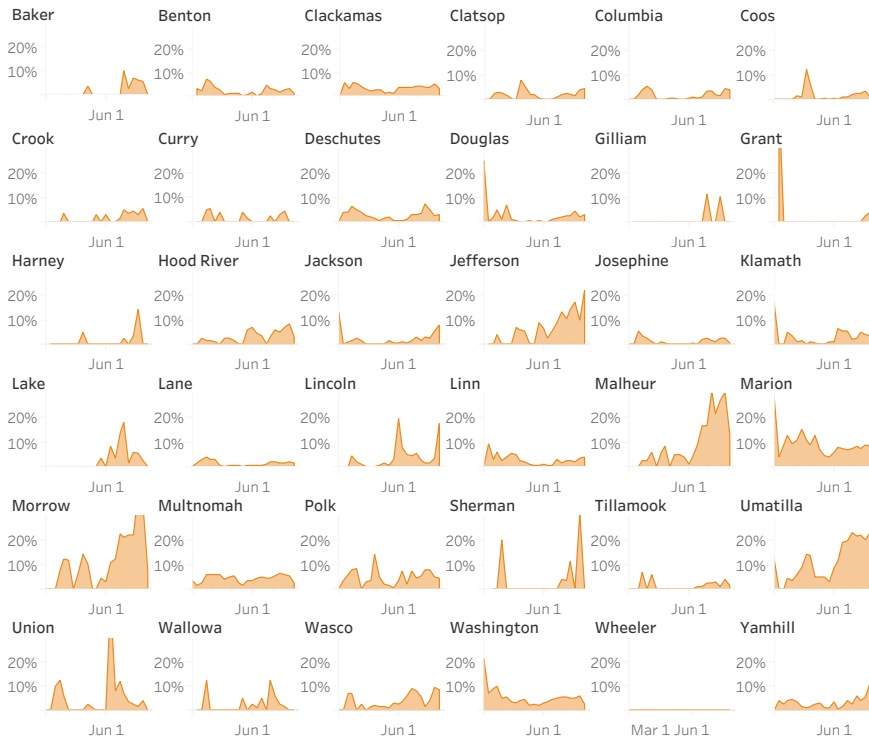
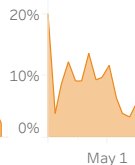
