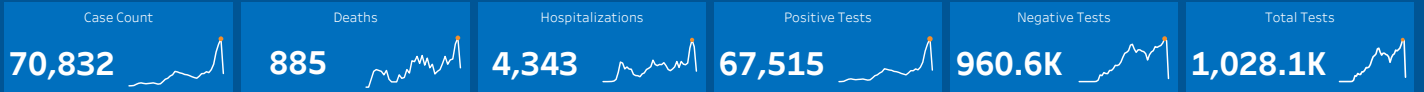

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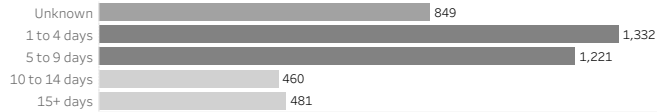
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### Length of Hospital Stay

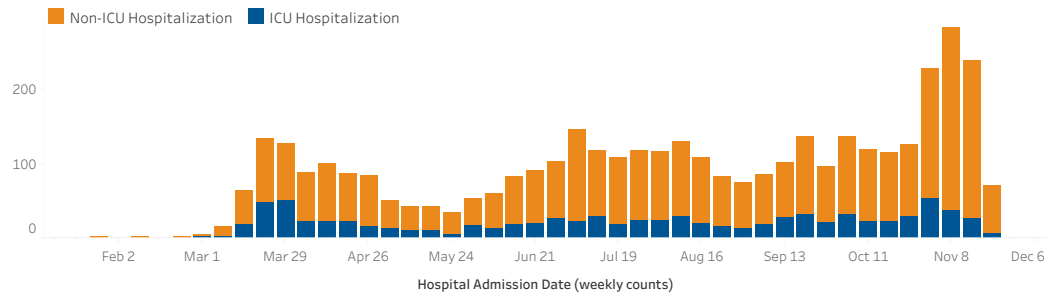
This chart shows the number of COVID-19 cases in Oregon who were ever hospitalized for their illness and the length of their hospital stays.
