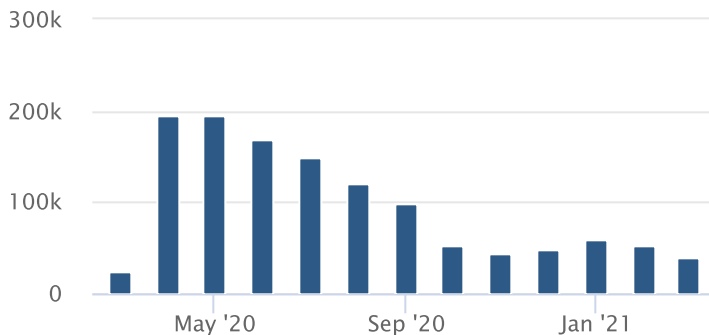

Oregon, March 2020 – March 2021



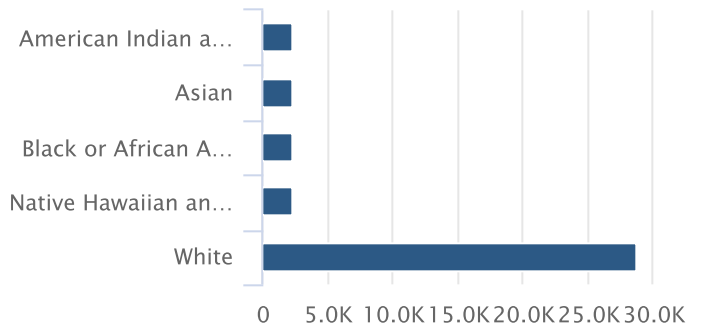

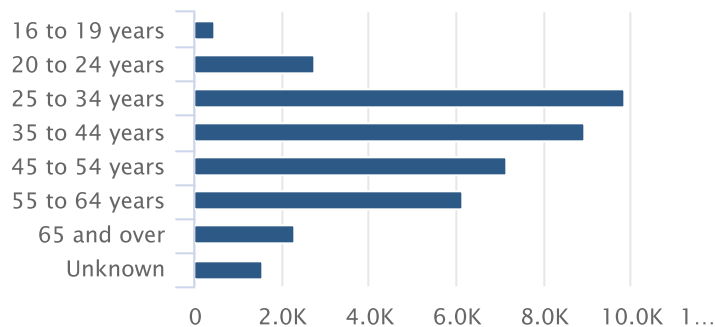

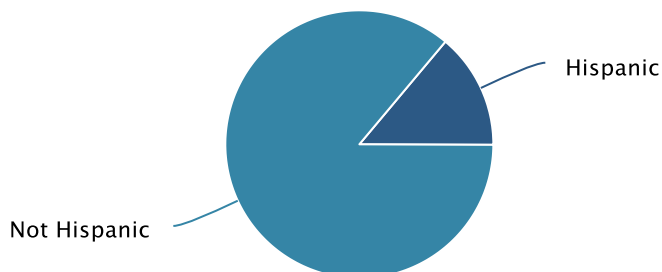

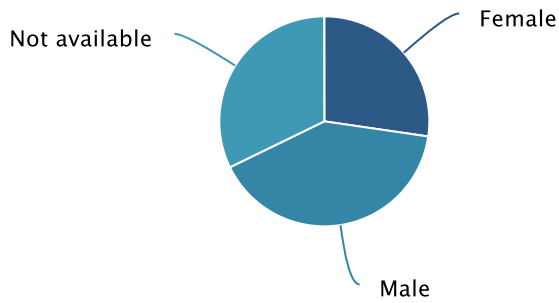

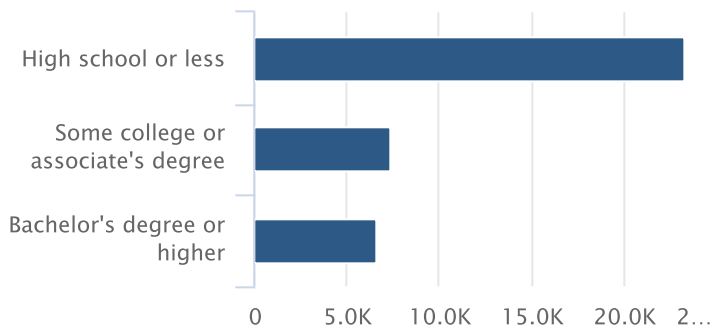

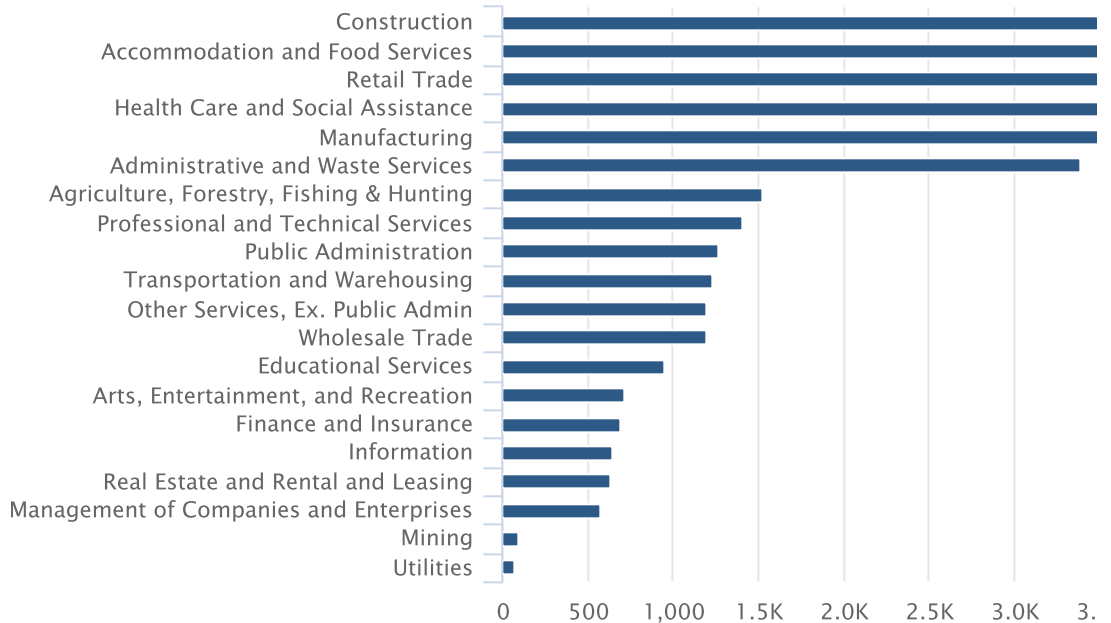

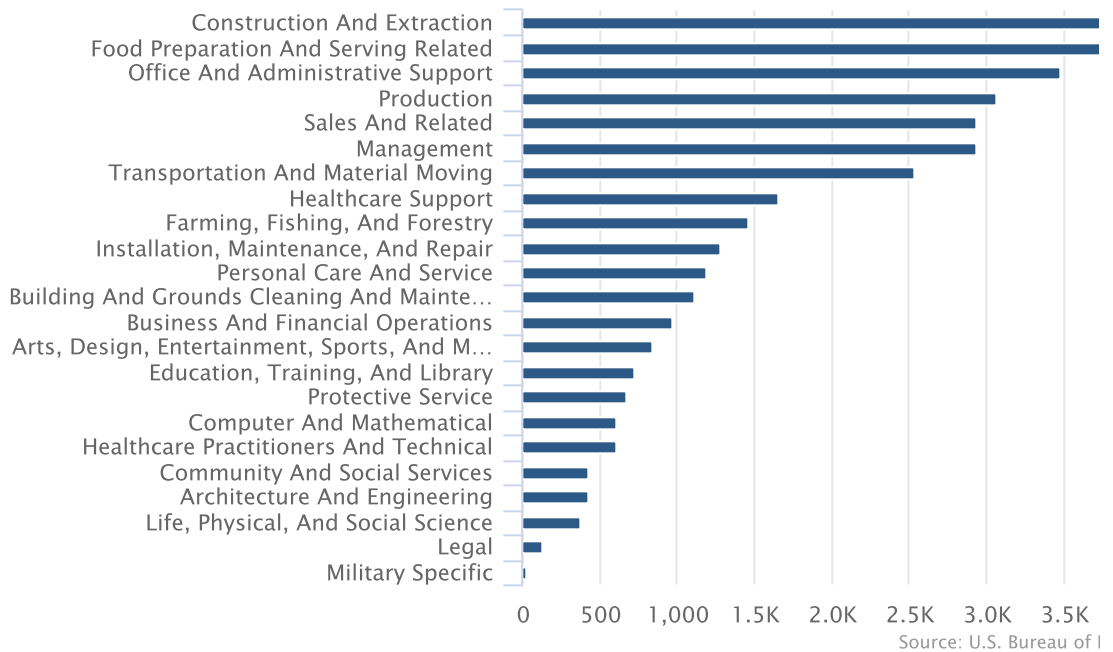
