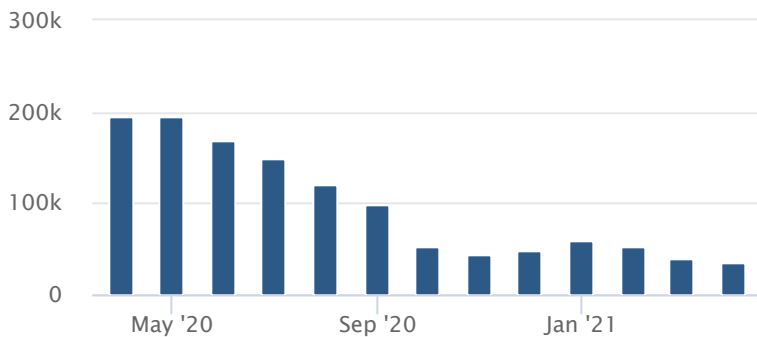
Continued Claimant Characteristics - Monthly Dashboard

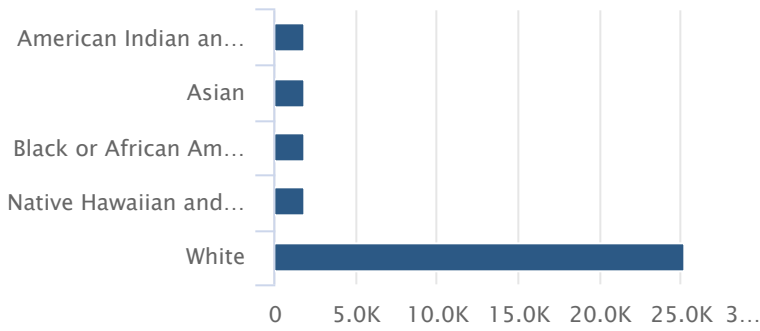

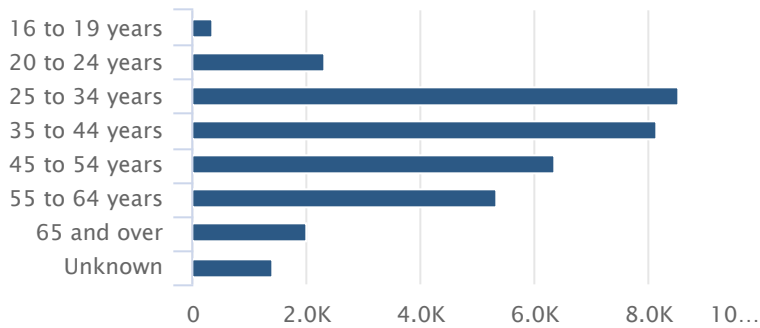

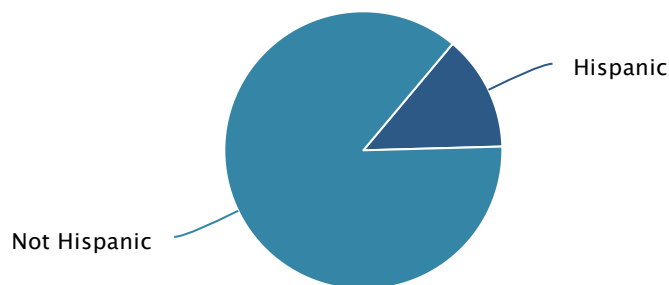

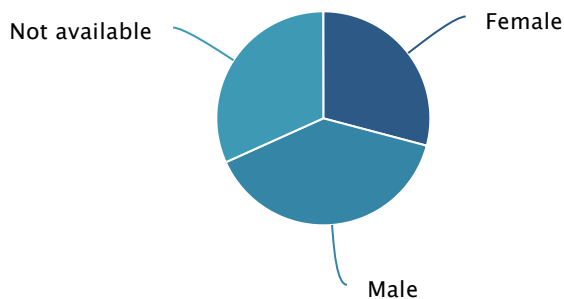

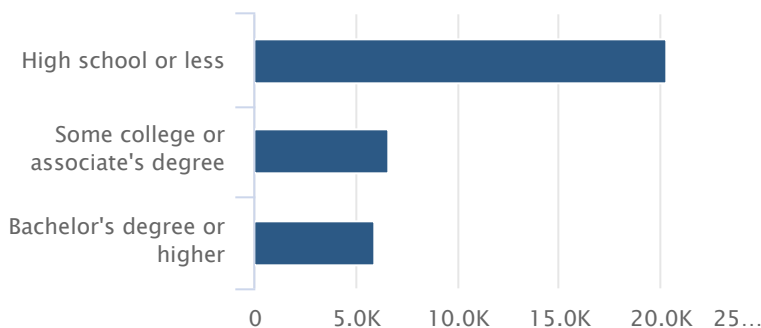

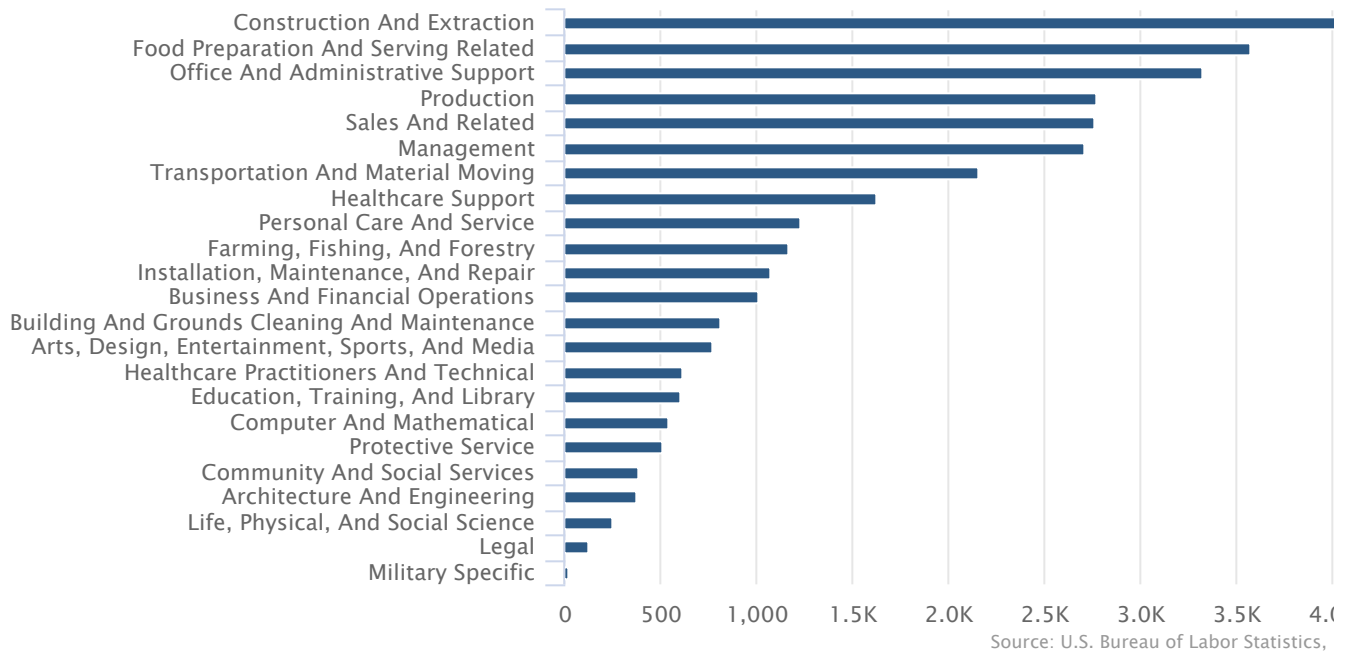
