



## Cougar Quota by Zone

While there is a general, statewide season for cougars, there are quotas set by zone. Once a quota in a certain zone is met, that zone will close for cougar hunting.

Below are the most recent numbers on cougar harvest by zone.



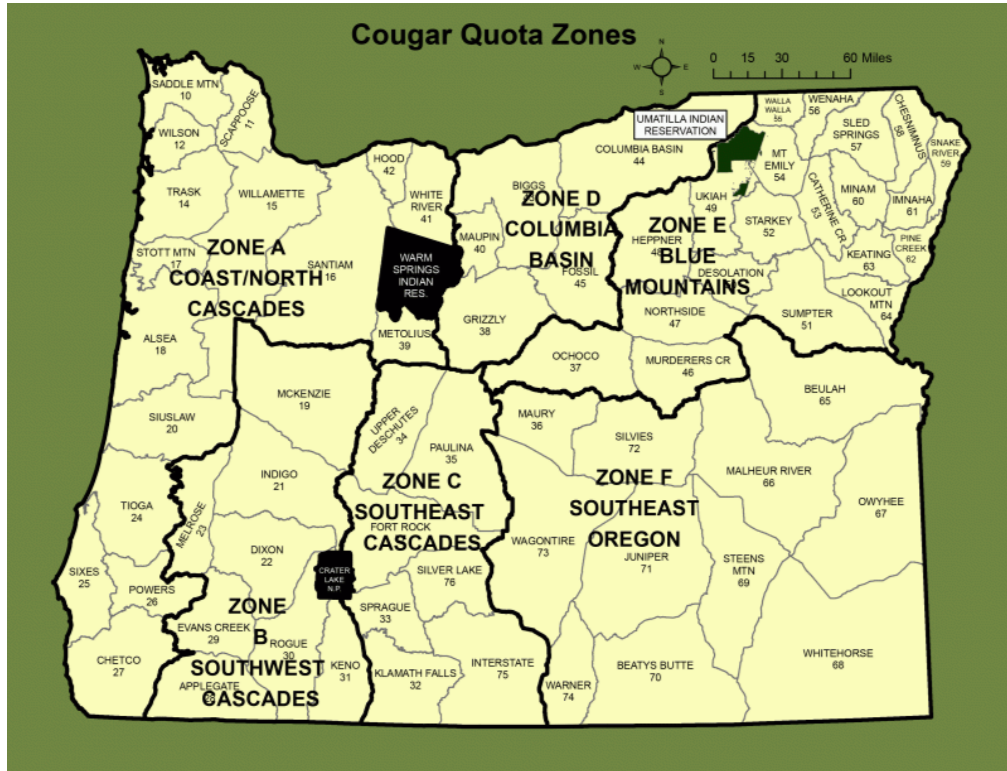

| Zone | Name                | Hunter | Non-Hunter | Total Mortality | Quota | Zone Status |
|------|---------------------|--------|------------|-----------------|-------|-------------|
| A    | Coast/North Cascade | 67     | 67         | 134             | 180   | Open        |
| B    | SW Cascade          | 39     | 66         | 105             | 200   | Open        |
| C    | SE Cascade          | 5      | 1          | 6               | 80    | Open        |
| D    | Columbia Basin      | 4      | 8          | 12              | 100   | Open        |
| E    | Blue Mountains      | 57     | 10         | 67              | 270   | Open        |
| F    | SE Oregon           | 18     | 4          | 22              | 140   | Open        |
