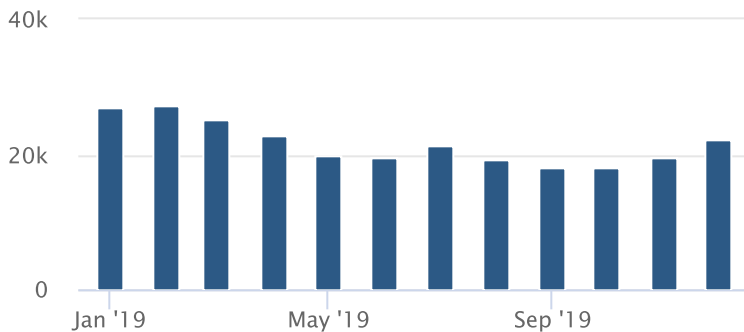

Oregon, January 2019 - December 2019



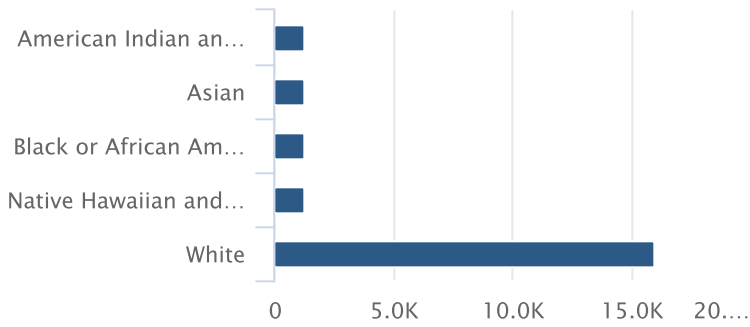

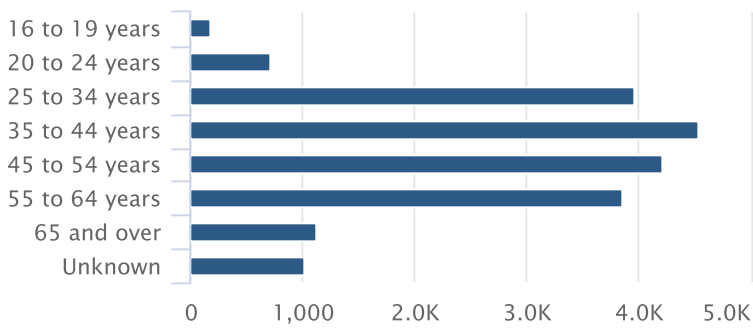

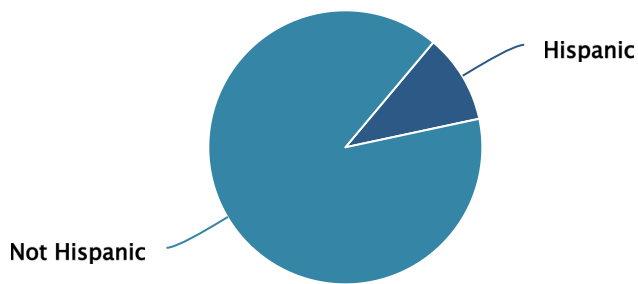

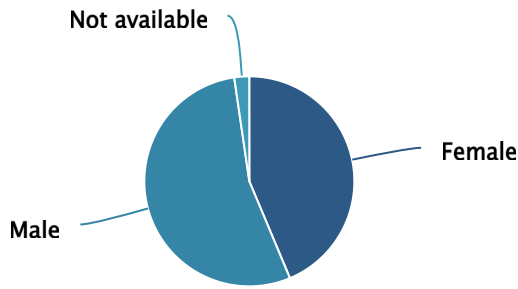

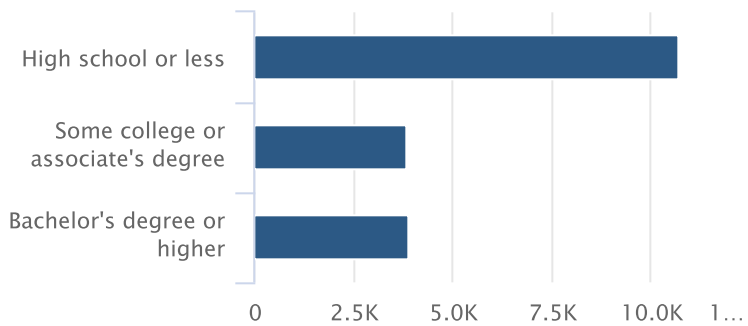

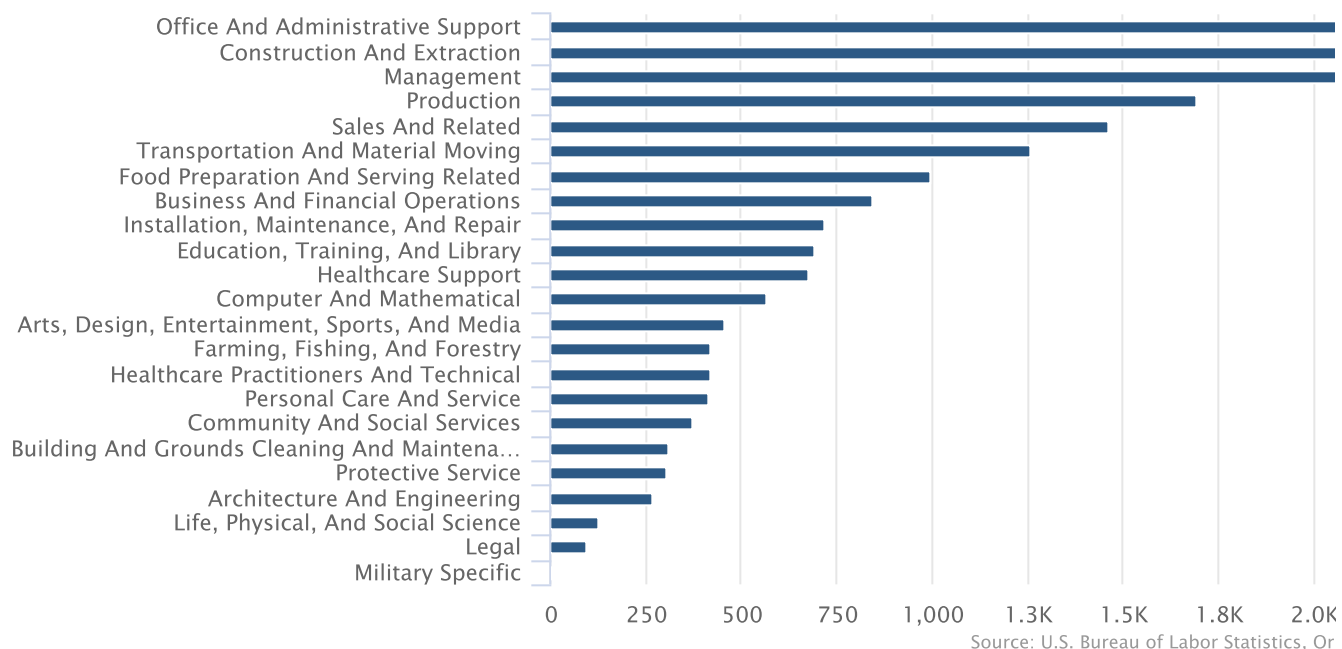
