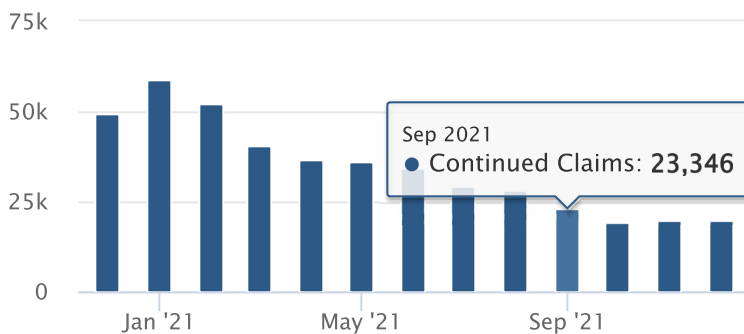

Oregon, December 2020 - December 2021



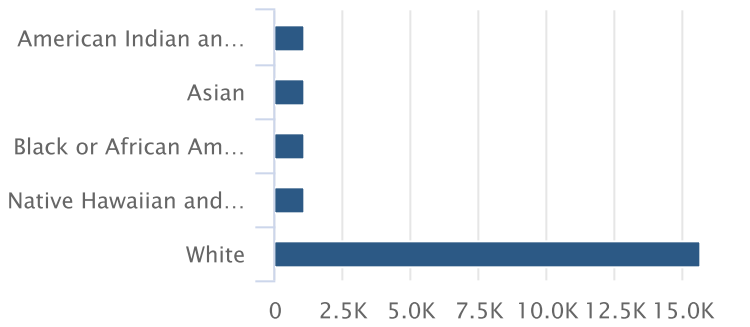

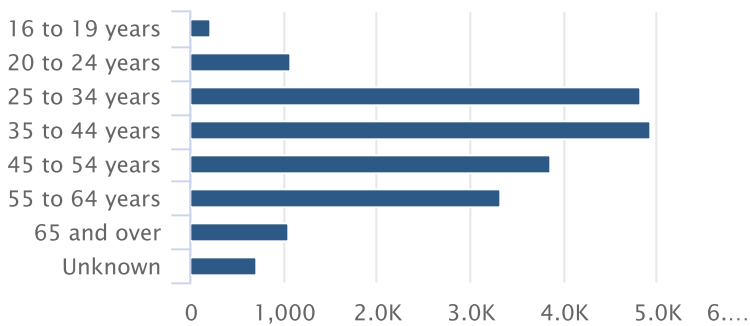

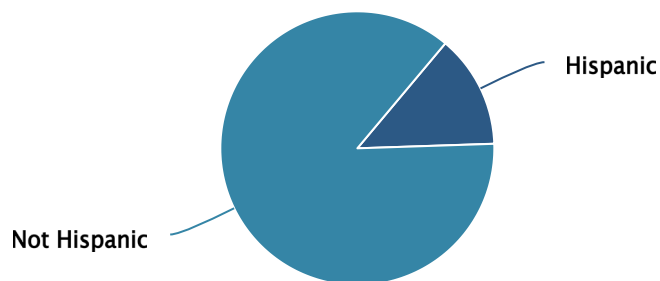

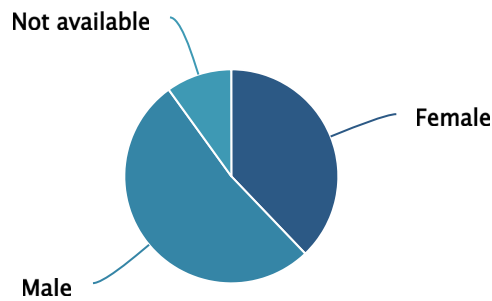

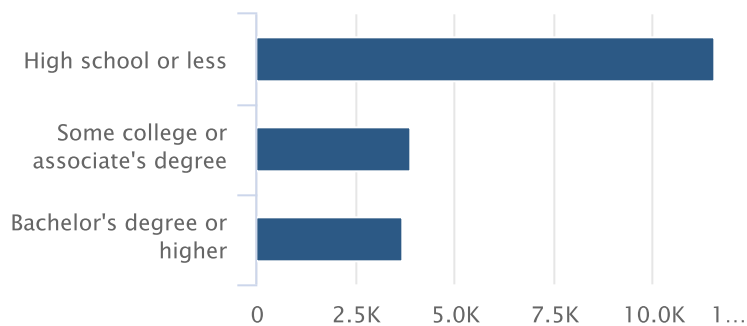

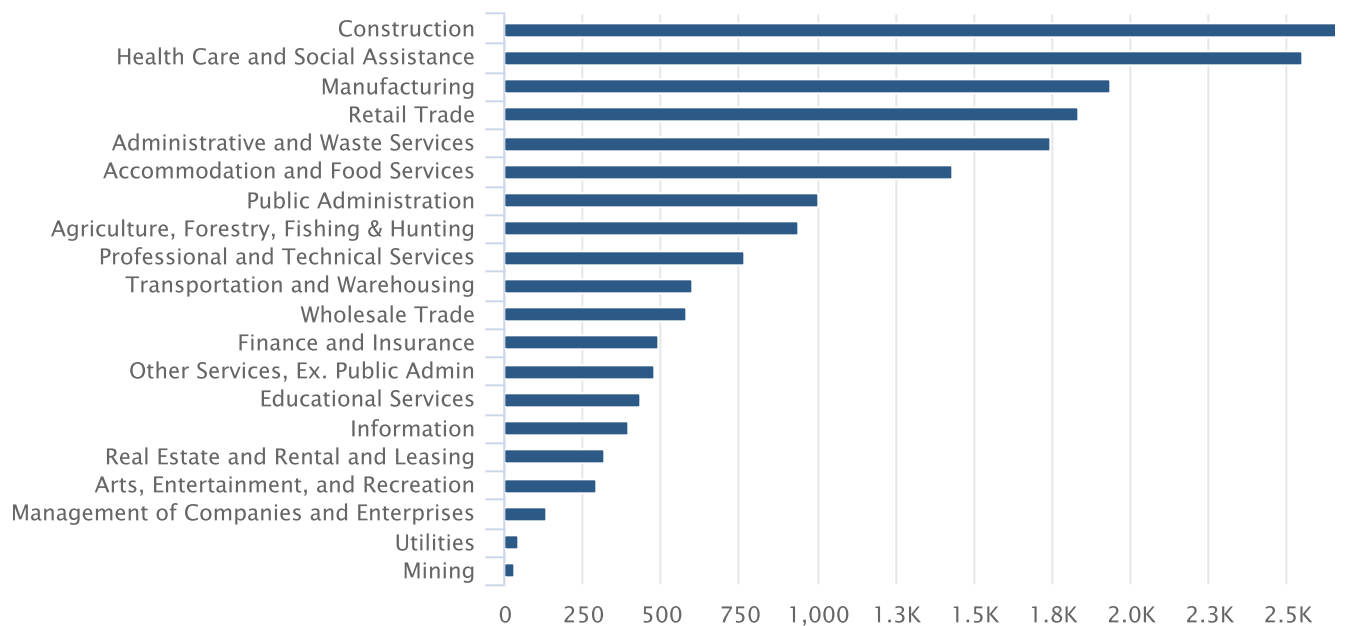

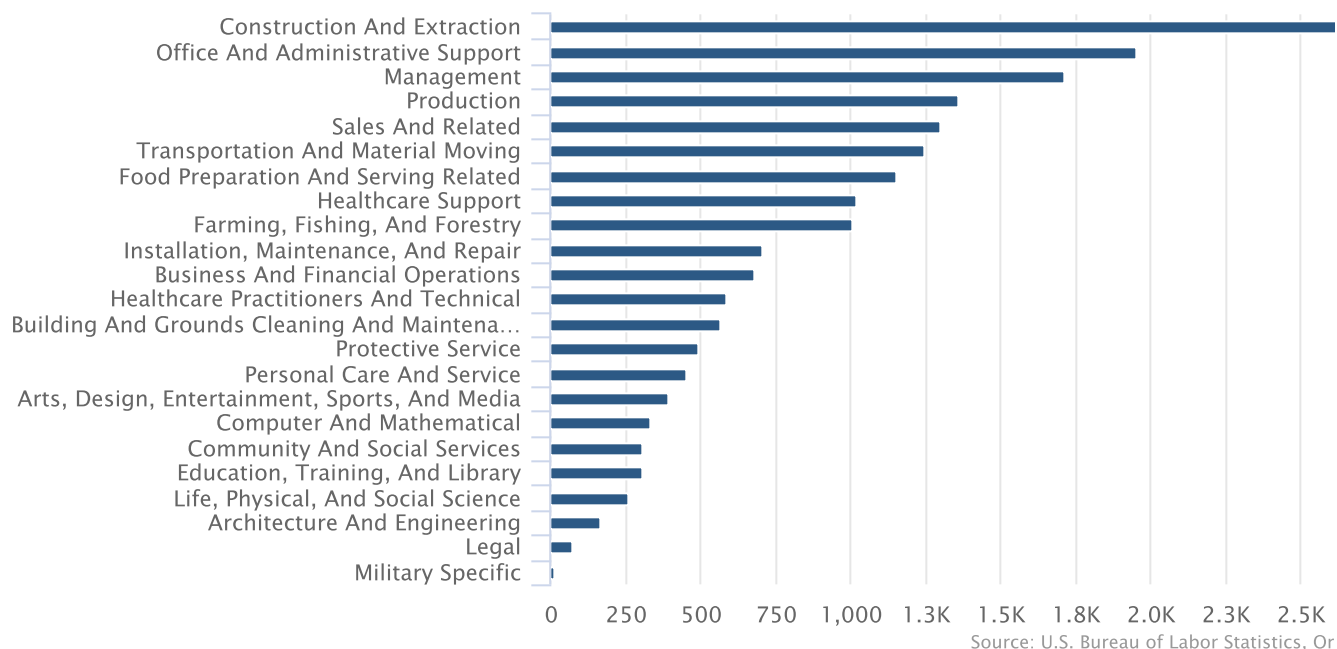
