

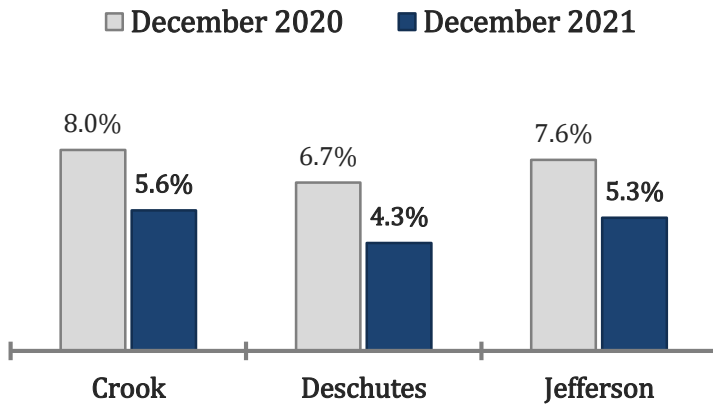

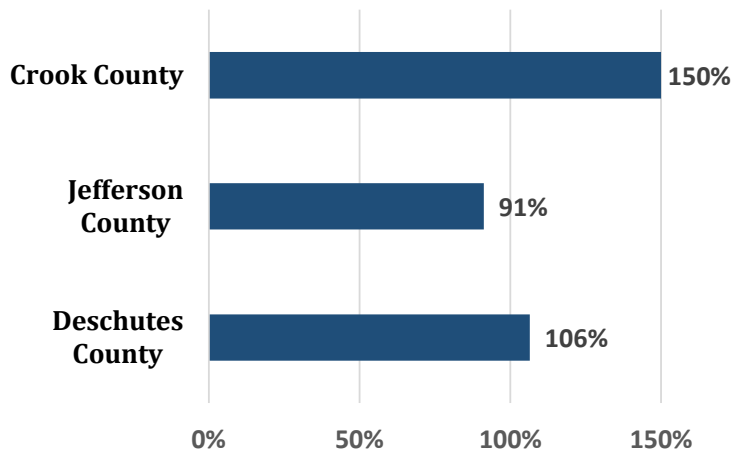
Local Area Unemployment Rates (Seasonally adjusted)

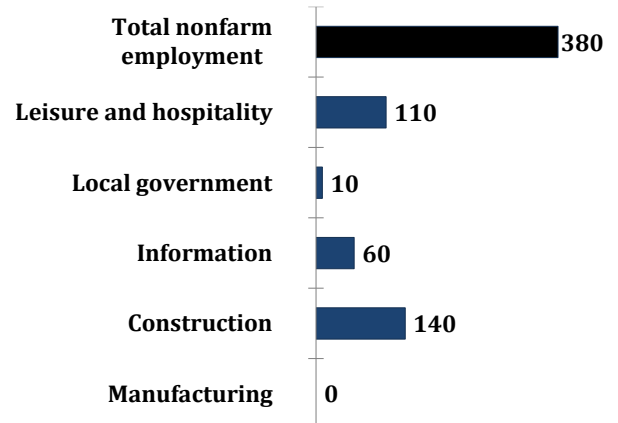


Deschutes County grew by an impressive 8.3% over the last 12 months, while Crook County grew by 5.9%. Jefferson County grew noticeably slower at 3.2%. For comparison, Oregon grew by 5.9%.

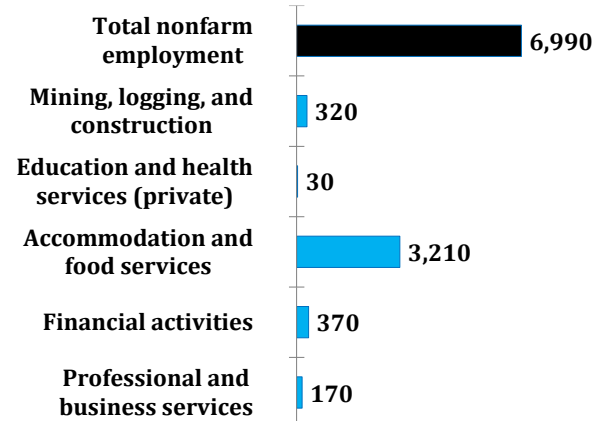
Each county has reached a different milestone in its respective economic recovery. Crook County has fully recovered from its initial job losses with more jobs than it had in February 2020, while Jefferson County has regained 91%. As of December 2021, Deschutes County regained all of its initial job losses.

Select Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

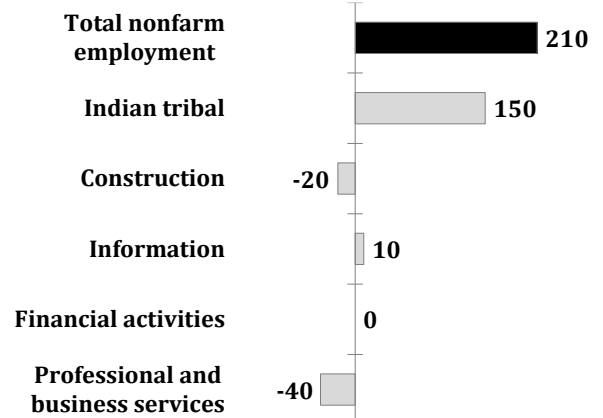
Crook County
