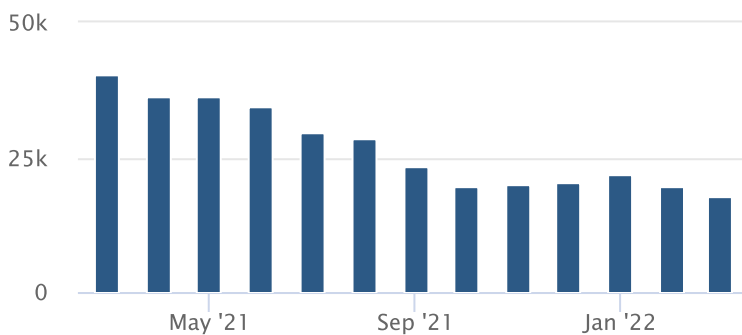

Oregon, March 2021 – March 2022



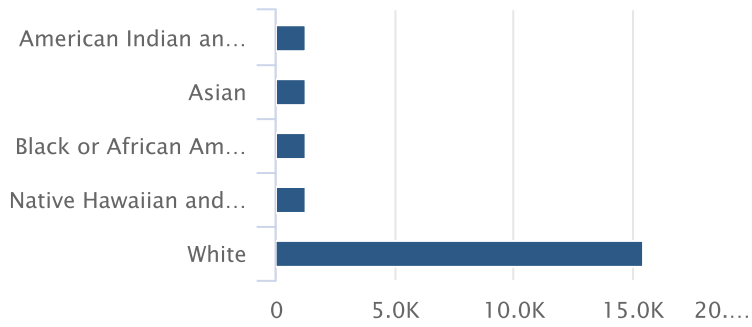

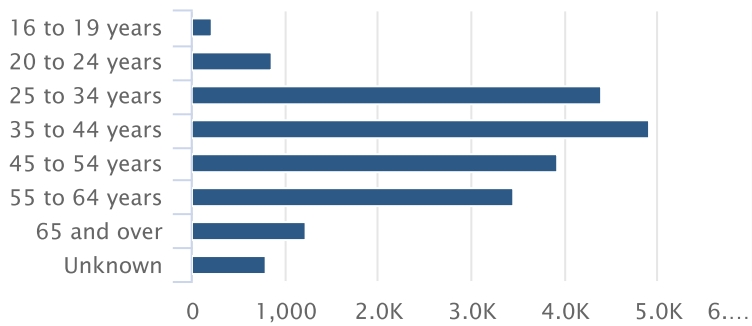

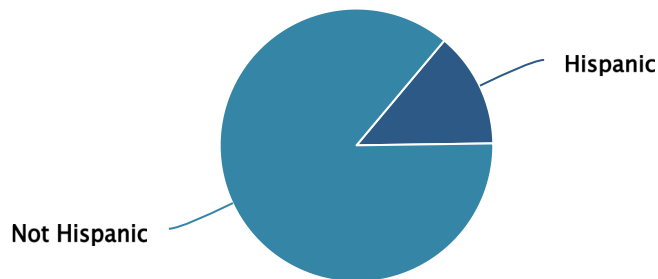

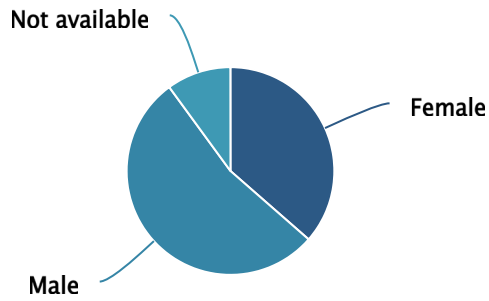

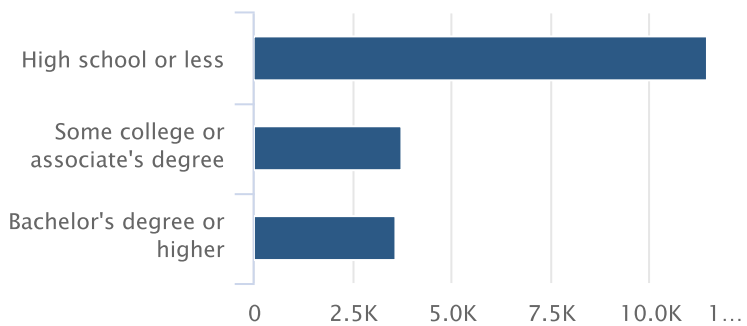

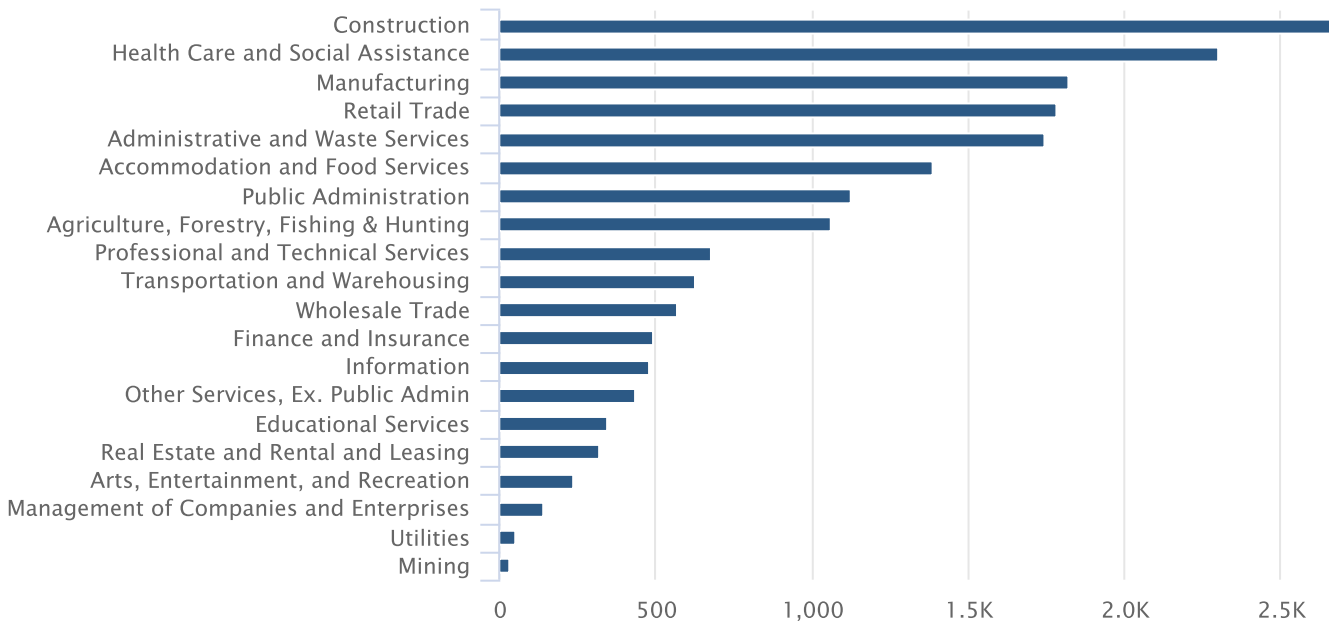

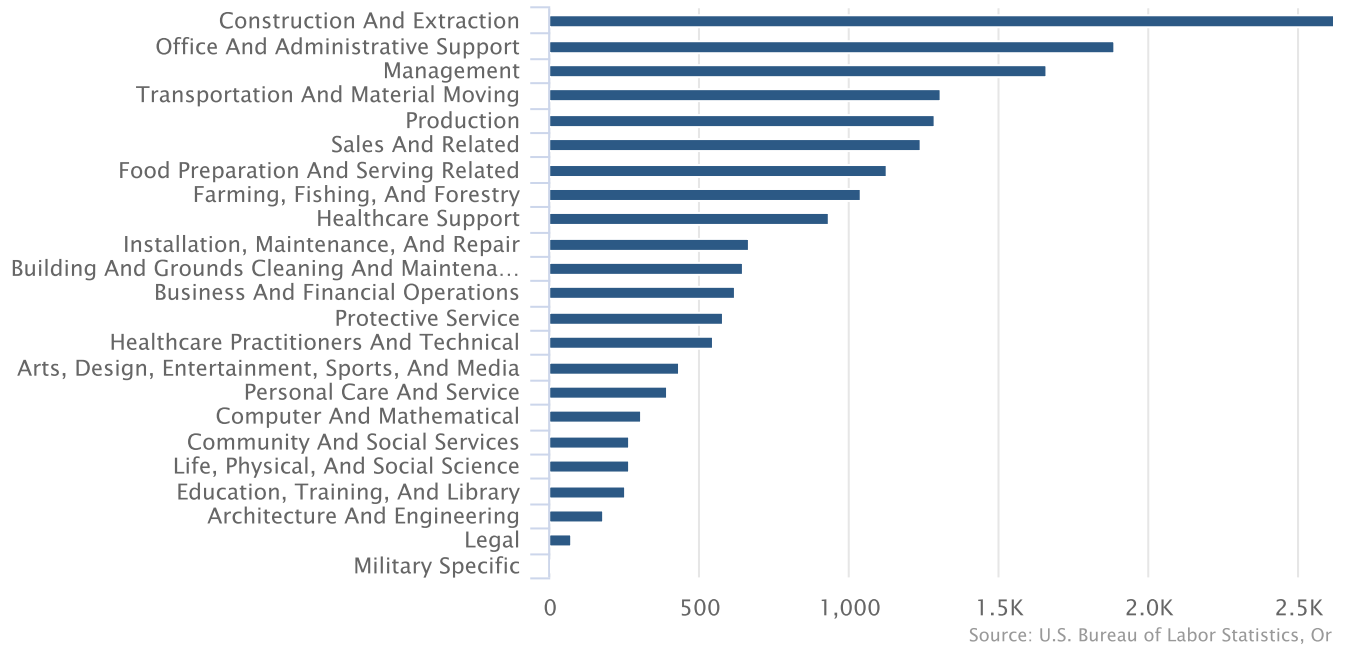
