Crater Lake License Plate Re-Design

Effective September 9, 2022

DMV began issuing Crater Lake registration plates 20 years ago, on August 26, 2002. The surcharge, minus DMV administrative costs, is transferred to the Oregon Community Foundation for use on Crater Lake projects.

The Crater Lake National Trust, in cooperation with ODOT and law enforcement, has redesigned the Crater Lake License plate.

DMV will start issuing the redesigned Crater Lake license plate on September 9, 2022. DMV will cease issuance of the current Crater Lake license plate on September 8, 2022. The new Crater Lake license plate will start with the configuration CB42001.

New Crater Lake License Plate:



Crater Lake license plates are also available as Custom (Personalized) and Amateur Radio Operator (Ham) plates.

The previous Crater Lake plate design will no longer be issued, but is still valid. The old plate design was issued for passenger cars, vans and pickups with a registration weight

of 10,000 pounds or less. They can be transferred to passenger cars, vans and pickups with a registration weight of 10,000 pounds or less.

The previous background was also issued to travel trailers and motor homes. There are approximately 485 that are currently registered. These plates can be transferred from travel trailers and motor homes to the same type vehicle.

The previous background was issued with the prefix CB, CK, CL and CA.

HB 3055: Human Trafficking Sanction	Effective September 23, 2022

HB 3055, Section 107 requires DMV to adopt administrative rules and program a new lifetime commercial driving privilege sanction for persons convicted of a crime in which a commercial motor vehicle was used and that involved an act or practice of severe forms of trafficking in persons.

Persons convicted of a crime in which a commercial motor vehicle was used and that involved an act or practice of severe forms of trafficking in persons as defined in rule will receive a lifetime commercial driving privilege sanction. This sanction will be based on offense dates that occur on September 23, 2022 or later.
